



Pastoral School of Chicago

The only online Orthodox Theological School providing a Master's Degree in Theology has made another leap in its development – thanks to the help of great people like you! In 2017 thanks to your generosity, PSC has launched its Spanish-language program. This is the only comprehensive Orthodox Christian seminary in the Spanish language in the world. This was possible in large part to the generous


happens to them and to our Church. They can now find a place for themselves within Church walls, they can think about serving the Christ when they grow up, and they can build their future around the Church. This is priceless.

When Hurricane Irma tore off most of their roof, Fr Brendan and Matushka Mary Dougherty (St Brendan Western Rite Mission in Sarasota, FL) didn't have the funds to fix it. Waiting for FEMA to help would have resulted in the house needing much more extensive repairs. When the Doughertys applied to FFA, all available funds were allocated to different causes. So we gave them a small donation and a loan.
